## Singular and Plural Possessive Nouns

A **possessive noun** is a noun that shows who or what owns or has something. Add an **apostrophe (')** + **s** to a singular noun to make it possessive.

*My **dentist's** office is in my **uncle's** town.*

Add an **apostrophe** to the end of most plural nouns to make them possessive. Add an **apostrophe** + **s** to form the plural of possessive nouns that don't end in -s.

*The **children's** mother visited **three teachers'** rooms.*
